AUTHOR GUIDELINES

- 1. ACSAT follows double-blind review process.
- 2. The corresponding author needs to:
 - a. Fill in JESTEC copyright transfer form, signed by all authors, and upload it to the guest editors who are responsible for the special issue.
 - b. Required to send his/her latest CV with an alternative email.
- 3. The corresponding author need to make sure of the number of recent references not be less than 30% of the total number of the references used in the paper. The term "recent references" means journal articles and conference papers published in the past five years.
- 4. The author should format the paper according to the <u>template</u>. The paper should contain a list of nomenclature and a list of references. Please make sure that every symbol used is clearly defined with its SI units. Also, to follow exactly the format used in the reference citation. There is a different format if the reference is a journal paper, a textbook, website, etc. All are shown in the template.
